

TSCA - Declaration of Compliance

Information regarding Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), that can allow the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to restrict the use of existing substances.

The Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, enacted on June 22, 2016, includes a provision under TSCA section 6(h) requiring the United States EPA to take expedited action on specific persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals to address risk and reduce exposures to the extent practicable. On January 6, 2021 EPA, which is seen as the equivalent of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), issued final rules to reduce exposure to the PBT chemicals listed below. The regulations became legally effective as early as March 2021.

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE), CAS 1163-19-5
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate 3:1 (PIP 3:1), CAS 68937-41-7
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP), CAS 732-26-3
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd), CAS 87-68-3
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP), CAS 133-49-3
