

REACH Position Statement

On June 1st 2007 the Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) came into force.

Multi Circuit Boards Ltd. is among the „**downstream users**“ according to REACH. You procure exclusively non-chemical articles from us which are not intended to release any substance under normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Therefore, **Multi Circuit Boards Ltd. is not subject to obligational registration** nor is it bound to the creation of safety data sheets.


Based on the information currently available to us from our material suppliers, we can assure that **none of the SVHC listed substances** according to the current status [*see Multi-CB SVHC Declaration of Compliance*] **are contained in the Printed Circuit Boards** and other products, placed on the market by Multi Circuit Boards Ltd., in a concentration above 0.1 percent by mass (w/w). **Registration in the SCIP database** (Substances of Concern In articles / complex objects (Products)) is therefore **not required**.

In addition, we will promptly inform you in accordance with REACH - Article 33, if ingredients of our products are classified (from a level of > 0.1% by mass) as a particular concern of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA). As things stand, however, we do not expect that this will happen.

We are also in close contact with our suppliers, and are very attentive to the correct implementation of the REACH regulations which may require registration of the relevant substances in REACH.

Multi Circuit Boards Ltd. pays special attention to long-term security and continuity of supply.
